



• PRODUCTION ASSISTANCE

The Orange Television Network will encourage and strive for high production values from each producer and program. Getting a show produced for OTN will require someone, or some group, to provide production services. If you do not plan to do the production on your own and need production assistance, there are options that the General Manager will review with you.

OTN has production facilities that can be used. Usually they are used with staff from OTN but under special circumstances, a producer who has had a show approved for production can schedule production and post-production facilities. These situations are decided on a case-by-case basis with the General Manager.

Also, there are some production entities on campus that will, for a fee, produce your program. There are also private television production companies in the area should you like to explore those options. Each solution has its strengths and each will be discussed during the program proposal discussion.

Each approved program will need to be screened by the General Manager prior to airing on OTN. As the producer you may be asked for progress updates during the completion process to ensure that all criteria for solid production values are being met. If you have concerns about the production values of your show and your ability to ensure them, please discuss this *prior* to beginning production and/or post-production.

Assistance is limited and OTN will not assume any costs incurred for production of any kind without prior approval of the General Manager. This includes videotape, travel, DVD's, actors, equipment rentals or any fees associated with the show.
